

The Honor Level System of Discipline

At Greenville, we want you to be happy, successful, and safe. We also strive to provide an atmosphere in which it is pleasant for you to study and learn. For these reasons, we use an award winning program known as the Honor Level System of Discipline – HLD for short. It teaches you to be responsible in making good decisions. It also emphasizes care and respect for yourself and others. It is an incentive program which recognizes students for good behavior by providing rewards for students who make good choices. It also provides consistent and fair consequences for students who make poor choices.

A computer is used to keep track of the four honor levels in the system.

Each grade level will have different activities per quarter for students with 3 points or less.



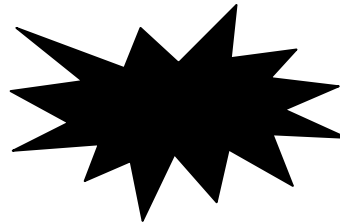
Determining Your Honor Level

The number of demerits acquired in 14 days determines your level. If you have not received any demerits, you are on Honor Level 1. You are eligible for all privileges, rewards, and special drawings. Earning up to ten demerits puts you on Honor Level 2. Level 2 students are entitled to most of the privileges of Level 1.

If you receive from 11-20 demerits, you drop to level 3. Level 3 students do not receive rewards and are not eligible to participate in SALSA activities or be a spectator at co-curricular games and activities. If you are on Level 3 and a member of a co-curricular team or activity group, you will be able to attend practices, but not participate in games and/or contests until you're back on Level 1 or 2. If you have 21 or more demerits, which is Level 4, you do not receive any rewards or privileges. In short, you attend school and that's it.

To summarize:

| Level Four | 21+ demerit points in 14 days |



Your Responsibilities

The Honor Level System requires you to be responsible for your actions. If you received an infraction, a detention notice will be given and you are expected to serve the detention. A notice states the infraction, who issued it, and the type of detention to be served. The date on which you will return to Honor Level 1, provided no further demerits are earned, is printed on the bottom. **If you do not fulfill the responsibility of serving your consequence, you automatically receive the next consequence and three or five additional demerits.**

The Infraction Slip

(Example Only)

One point demerits:

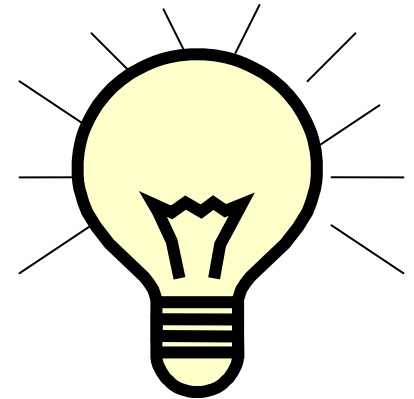
Arrive to class on time
Come to class with all necessary materials
Refrain from drinking soda, and eating candy, gum, snacks, etc.
Clean up after yourself
Off task behavior
Come to class with assignment completed

Three point demerits:

Move about the building in an orderly manner
Follow instructions from any adult in an appropriate manner
Follow classroom/school rules
Display appropriate behavior in commons, courtyard, gym, halls, locker room
Continuous repetition of 1 point infractions
Follow student dress code
Use appropriate language

Five point demerits:

Respect school property and the property of others
Profanity
Treat peers and staff with respect
Display appropriate classroom behavior





Detentions

One point infractions will never result in more than a 15 minute noon detention unless the behavior is continuous. If it is continuous, a three point infraction may be issued. **Because this is a “gum free school” you will automatically receive a one point infraction if you are caught chewing gum.**

More serious infractions within a 14 day period can result in three to five demerits causing you to work through the progressive stages of consequence including 30 minute noon detentions, administrative conference and parent notification, after school detentions, or in-school suspensions.

To summarize:

- 1 infraction – 15 min noon detention
- 2 infractions – 30 min noon detention
- 3 infractions – 30 min noon detention, administrative conference, parent notification
- 4 infractions – after school detention 3:15 – 4:00 in the office
- 5 infractions – in-school suspension

Getting Back to Honor Level 1

The Honor Level System is forgiving. If you earn one demerit and have dropped to Honor Level 2, you can be back on Level 1 in 7 days provided no additional demerits are earned (this 7 day period is referred to as a “7 day window”). It is possible to regain good standing in a relatively short period of time. Three and five point infractions fall off on the 14th day. Both the 7 and 14 day windows include weekends, holidays, even vacation days! The system works for you even when you’re not in school! The system is fair and it rewards good behavior. Computerized record keeping makes it possible for you to know your current standing, and it keeps track of all infractions the entire year.



ALL STARS

To reward all students who have a total of three or less demerit points, there will be a trip scheduled at the end of the school year for each grade level.
